GRANT APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

Guidelines

ELIGIBILITY

NAWIC Core Purpose is to “enhance the success of women in the Construction Industry”, so men need not apply for this Scholarship. It is open to ALL women in the construction industry (including current NAWIC members).

- 1) Trade Schools / Junior Colleges:** Available to 1st year and beyond students with a maximum amount of \$500.00 per year, per student who are studying in construction related courses; see below to complete application.
- 2) University Graduate / Post Graduate Programs:** Dollar amount for this scholarship \$1000.00 per year, per student. Must have completed their 2nd year of a construction-related course of study.
- 3) Applications must include the following:**
 - Transcript (Jr College/Trade School 1st year applicants may omit this document)
 - Letters of recommendation from any of the following: teacher or other school representative, employer, community or school activity project leaders. (minimum of two)
 - Essay of not more than 350 words outlining what your college experience means to you, what your goals are pertaining to career, community activities and future achievements
 - Thoughts and goals of NAWIC; see websites....nawic.org, nawictucson.org, nawicpacificsouthwestregion.org
 - Completed application form
- 4) All Scholarships may be re-applied for each year, with new applicants receiving priority in funding.**
