SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS Guidelines

1) *ELIGIBILITY*

NAWIC Core Purpose is to “enhance the success of women in the Construction Industry”, so men need not apply for this Scholarship. It is open to ALL women in the construction industry (including current NAWIC members.

- 2) **Continuing Education:** Dollar amount for this award varied with maximum of \$500.00; tuition support for continuing education programs in construction related course of study. Applications must include; completed application, certifiable copy of registration with fee charged for class(s), and/or receipt for cost of educational supplies for related course.
- 3) **Job Support:** Dollar amount for this award varied with maximum of \$500.00; this eligibility requirement is for purpose of procuring tools or supplies needed for job placement. i.e. specialty tools needed for specific job requirements or apparel needed for specific job. Application must include; completed application, proof of purchase or invoice for tools needed for specific job, certifiable letter of intent to hire from employer with listing of specific tools and/or apparel needed for job placement with said employer.
- 4) **Trade Schools / Junior Colleges:** Available to 1st year and beyond students with a maximum amount of \$500.00 per year in construction related course of study; Application requirements the same as University program.
- 5) **University Graduate / Post Graduate Programs:** Dollar amount for this scholarship \$1000.00 per year. Must have completed their 2nd year of a construction-related course of study.
- 6) **Trade, College and University applications must include the following:**
 - Transcript & College/Trade School 1st year applicant may omit this document)
 - Letters of recommendation from any of the following: teacher or other school representative, employer, community or school activity project leaders. (minimum of two)

- Essay of not more than 350 words outlining what your college experience means to you, what your goals are pertaining to career, community activities and future achievements
- Thoughts and goals of NAWIC
- Completed application form

All Scholarships may be re-applied for each year, with new applicants receiving priority in funding.
